Speed Indicator Devices

The Parish Council has purchased a Speed Indicator Device (SID) in response to the traffic surveys which have been conducted around the villages.

Together with HCC Highways the PC have found 8 different locations for the SID. As Highways are always trying to keep road signage to a minimum we have in most areas used posts which are already in place.

To enable to SID to work effectively there needs to be a sight view of 90 metres – therefore cannot be placed near to bends in the road. The verge also needs to be wide enough (ie not to interfere with services/ditch/culverts etc) and safe enough to take the post. Some of the posts which are mainly 30mph signs will need replacing as they are considered to be in a poor condition before they can take the SID. Highways will be undertaking this work shortly.

Apart from Church Road where the SID will be placed each side of the road other locations only require one post as the camera can be turned to face oncoming traffic from both directions.

Locations:

- Church Road (both sides of the road) outside Rookesbury Hall
- Liberty Road (by the field entrance next to Springfield House)
- Heath Road (near to the Meon Wood entrance on the opposite side of road)
- Heath Road (on the opposite side of the road to Bradshaw House)
- High Street (outside Oakdene House)
- Station Road (from Hambledon Road up the hill on the left 30mph sign)
- Hambledon Road (on hill coming into Brockbridge)
