SINC	Sites of Importance for Nature Conservation A SINC is a non-statutory designation and carries no legal obligations but provides opportunities to encourage management sympathetic to wildlife, such as by the provision of grants as well as allowing the most important areas for wildlife to be considered during the planning process. The areas within the South Downs national Park are noted as an asset, the land has the highest protection available in the UK.
