Garden Waste Collections 7 January 2013

If you live in the areas listed below (calendar 16) and were expecting a garden waste collection on Monday 7 January 2012 and you are unable to wait until your next scheduled collection on Friday 18 January 2013, please contact Customer Services on 0300 300 0013 during this week and a collection will be arranged.

Please leave your garden waste sack and real Christmas tree out for collection.
